From I-5:

- Take the Mercer-Fairview Exit. Note – if you are going northbound on I-5 this exit is on your left.
- At the first light, take a right onto Fairview.
- At the next light, take a left onto Valley St, which will turn into Broad St.
- Follow Broad to Denny Ave. (the Space Needle will be directly on your right) and turn right.
- Follow Denny (the name will change to Western Ave, and then Elliott Ave.) until you see the overhead sign for the “Piers 86-91, Magnolia Bridge” exit. Stay in right-hand lane.
- Get on the Magnolia Bridge exit and stay in the right hand lane. The Elliott Bay Marina/Smith Cove exit is marked. It is the second exit while on the bridge and the ONLY exit off to the right.
- Take the RIGHT ramp exit, which slopes down under the Magnolia Bridge (do not go up and over the Magnolia Bridge)
- At the end of the ramp, take a left under the Bridge, and follow road along the water to the marina.

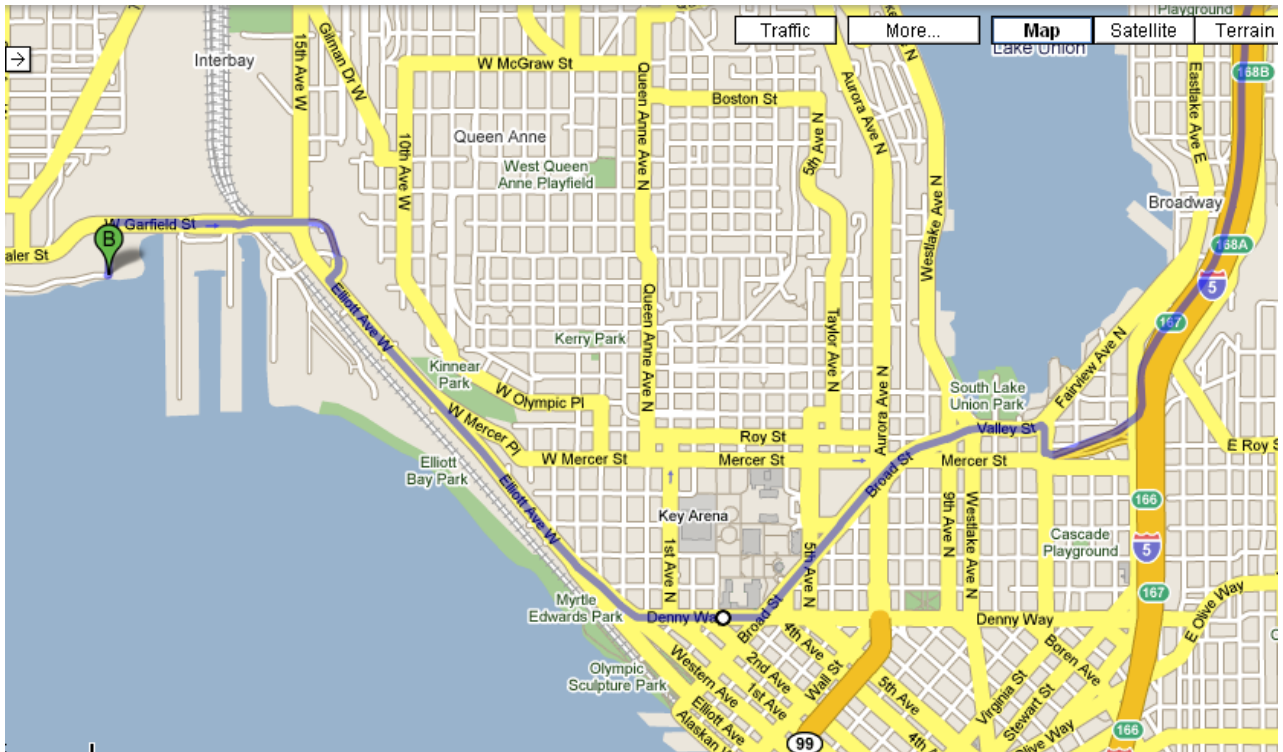
From the Bainbridge Ferry

- Take a LEFT onto Alaskan Way and follow as it curves to stoplight at Elliott Ave.
- Take a LEFT on to Elliott Ave (or Western, one block further)
- Follow until it merges with Western, taking a left onto the continuation of Elliott Ave, if necessary
- Watch for an overhead sign reading “Piers 86-91, Magnolia Bridge” exit
- Get on the Magnolia Bridge exit and stay in the RIGHT hand lane. The Elliott Bay Marina/Smith Cove exit is marked. It is the second exit while on the bridge and the ONLY exit off to the right.
- Take the RIGHT ramp exit, which slopes down under the Magnolia Bridge (do not go up and over the Magnolia Bridge)
- At the end of the ramp, take a left under the Bridge, and follow road along the water to the marina.

When you reach the Marina:

- Park (free) in the spots closest to the road/grass labeled “Guest Parking.” If no spots are available in these areas, call us or visit the Harbormaster’s office for a guest parking permit. The office is located on the water side of the main building, below Palisades Restaurant
- Salish staff will meet you at the top of the dock. We are usually moored at **N-dock** (all the way to the left facing the water, closest to the city) or if not there, try **G-dock** (below the main building, under Palisades Restaurant, near the giant compass rose in the cement).
